

1. CONNECTORS



Connectors can be used to connect metric tubes, hoses and fittings to each other in whatever configuration. They are divided into 3 ranges:

- very light
- light
- and heavy series

Designed for nominal pressures up to 800 bar (heavy series) and available in various geometries such as

- straight
- elbow (e.g. 45° and 90°)
- tee
- cross

2. MALE STUD TUBE FITTINGS



Male stud fittings allow the connection of a metric tube with a port. From metric stud end with captive seal to the imperial stud end with Form A, Gates EMB offers a wide range of stud end fittings. Male stud tube fittings are available in (according to ISO 8434-1 / DIN 2353)

- very light
- light
- and heavy series

Designed for nominal pressures up to 800 bar (heavy series) and available in various geometries such as

- straight
- elbow (e.g. 45° and 90°)
- and tee

3. ADJUSTABLE TUBE FITTINGS



Adjustable tube fittings allow the connection of minimum one metric tube with another tube fitting or port and can be assembled in any direction. Adjustable tube fittings are available (according to ISO 8434-1 / DIN 2353) in

- very light
- light
- and heavy series

Designed for nominal pressures up to 800 bar (heavy series) and available in various geometries such as

- elbow (e.g. 45° and 90°)
- and tee

4. REDUCERS AND GAUGE FITTINGS



Reducers are straight fittings and are used to reduce from one thread size to another thread size or from one metric tube size to another. Reducers thread to thread are not classified in series like connectors or male stud fittings. Reducers metric tube to metric tube (DKO) are classified (according to ISO 8434-1 / DIN 2353) in

- very light
- light
- and heavy series

Designed for nominal pressures up to 800 bar (heavy series).

Gauge fittings are straight fittings, which are used to connect a gauge with another fitting, tube or hose. Available with standard 24° cone, DKO or standpipe in

- very light
- light
- and heavy series

Designed for nominal pressures up to 630 bar (heavy series).

5. VALVES



Check valves allow the connection of metric tube to metric tube or tube to hose or to port. Check valves control the flow in a hydraulic system and open at a defined fixed pressure. Standard opening pressure for RD, RV and RZ is 1,0 bar. Other opening pressures are marked on the valve to allow a clear identification of opening pressure.

Valves are available in

- light
- > and heavy series. (according to ISO 8434-1 / DIN 2353)

Designed for nominal pressures up to 400 bar (heavy series).

ARV valves are only available in very light series with pressure ratings up to 100 bar. While RD, RV and RZ are coned valves, the ARV are ball valves. Typical applications for these valves are mainly lubrication lines.

6. ACCESSORIES



Accessories have a high variety, from plugs in different sealing forms and sizes to sealing rings or support sleeves. This range contains every component to complete your hydraulic fittings range.

7. CONTROL SYSTEM



Gates EMB offers a wide range of test couplings, test hoses, pressure gauges and other accessories according to international standards. The extensive range allows our customers to buy tube fittings and control system from one single source.

8. CONNECTING SYSTEMS (WELDING NIPPLES, FLARING, CUTTING RINGS, FS)

The cutting ring is the most common connecting system for tube fittings. Gates EMB double edge cutting ring and double edge cutting ring with soft seal in combination with our final-assembly machine OPTICAM 4S are a strong and valuable solution for serial production.


The Gates EMB FS System with its low degree of deformation is an excellent alternative in areas where no cutting ring or flaring is allowed.

The ABO system of Gates EMB is a soft sealed connection used instead of a JIC connection, which allows the customer to use DIN tube fittings and reduce the risk of leakages.

The system can also be used for nearly all applications as we provide a comprehensive product portfolio of DIN 2353, ISO 8434-1 tube fittings. The EMB-FS® system and assembly procedure guarantees you minimum tube stress, fast assembly and maximum retention forces

A function ring supports the final assembly. It integrates an elastomer seal into the system and protects against excessive tightening. Frictional tension between tube and fitting cone is assured with the metallic seal function. Vulcanised soft seals ensure the leak-free performance in extreme working conditions as well. Safe assembly is indicated by a clearly noticeable assembly stop.



KEEPING YOU UP TO DATE WITH SAFETY AND LEGISLATION

In Europe the main safety Directive covering hose and machinery products is the European Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC. This provides the regulatory basis for the harmonisation of essential health and safety requirements for machinery at European Union level. In practical terms, however, the best way to be sure you're complying with the Directive is to comply with the Harmonised European Standards. These standards are tools that help manufacturers and users comply with the Directive by giving you practical guidance on how to meet its requirements. The two most important standards on safety requirements for hydraulic hose assemblies are:

- ISO 12100:2010
 ('Safety of machinery: Basic concepts, general principles for design')
- ISO 4413:2010 ('Safety of machinery Safety requirements for fluid power systems and their components – Hydraulics')

The good news is that the Gates Integrated System of hoses, couplings, self-assembly machines and crimp data – used together – ensure you fully comply with this European Machinery Directive.
